NOTIFICATION

In compliance of the approval granted in 35th, 36th & 38th Board Meeting, the following is notified for information of all concerned.

1. TIME LIMIT FOR IMPROVEMENT OF MARKS OF SSC/HSSC

It has been decided that the chance for improvement (Once only) shall be upto a maximum of 05 years after passing SSC/HSSC, but with the condition that the candidate must have not taken next higher Examination and have not obtained migration/NOC. For fulfillment of the condition the candidate must provide an affidavit for not having taken next higher Examination. A candidate may opt any one or more subjects/papers, there is no restriction on selection/choice of subjects for Improvement.

2. INTRODUCTION OF IMPROVEMENT IN 9TH AND 1ST YEAR IN REPLACEMENT OF QUASHMENT/CANCELLATION OF RESULT

The policy of Quashment of Result in Class 9th and 1st year is discarded and replaced with a chance of Improvement in the subsequent Supplementary Examination. Such candidates may opt one or more papers or the whole part.

This has been decided to benefit the students in terms of keeping their previous result intact which was otherwise cancelled and could not be reclaimed.

3. 2ND CHANCE FOR IMPROVEMENT OF DIVISION IN SSC/HSSC

- There shall be only one chance for Improvement of Marks in SSC/ HSSC, however the candidates with 3rd Division shall be allowed one additional chance for Improvement of Division, before taking next higher examination.
- The students who have been allotted Roll Number for Improvement of Marks but have remained absent from Examination, the chance for Improvement shall not be considered as availed.

4. ADDITIONAL SUBJECT(S) TIME LIMIT (SSC/HSSC)

A candidate after passing SSC or HSSC Examination, may opt for additional subject(s) (Not having practicals), once, in any of four consecutive Examinations.

5. APPEARANCE OF A CANDIDATE WHO HAS PASSED PART-I BUT NOT APPEARED IN PART-II (SSC/HSSC) WITH A GAP OF MORE THAN 02 YEARS

The candidate who has passed Part-I and did not appear in Part-II for more than two years are allowed to take the examination in composite style i.e Part-I and Part-II in one go. In case of involving practical subjects, the admission form must be sent through the concerned institution.

6. CLARIFICATION OF MISSING TWO CONSECUTIVE CHANCES AFTER APPEARING IN PART-II (SSC/HSSC)

It is clarified that if a candidate misses two consecutive chances after appearing in Part-II and failed in one or two subjects of any part, will have to appear in the whole subjects of that part in which he has failed. The part in which he has already passed will require no further appearance for examination. But if a candidate has failed in one or more subjects of each part, then he has to appear in both parts but in Arts only.

7. APPEARANCE OF A CANDIDATE HAVING SCIENCE SUBJECTS AFTER EXPIRY OF UFM PUNISHMENT

It is clarified that if a candidate of science group is punished for two or more Exams, after expiry of the duration of punishment, he will be allowed to appear in the same subjects/group.


It is also pertinent to mention that in any of the above cases, if a candidate is allowed to appear in Exam after expiry of a certain period and if the scheme of studies have changed during this period, the candidate has to appear in the new scheme of studies.
