



SUBJECT: CYBERSECURITY AWARENESS AND DIGITAL CAPACITY BUILDING IN COMPLIANCE WITH PM DIRECTIVE

The Prime Minister's Office, vide U.O. No. 58/ITM/DS(IA-III) dated 29-09-2022, directed all Ministries/Divisions and their attached departments/entities to strengthen cybersecurity measures and secure their cyberspace, including the establishment of designated Cybersecurity Focal Points.

2. In compliance with the above directive, various training sessions have been conducted to enhance cybersecurity awareness. However, with the rapid expansion in the use of Artificial Intelligence and digital platforms in official work, the risks of cyber threats, hacking, and data breaches have increased significantly. It is therefore essential to further strengthen institutional preparedness and digital resilience.

3. Accordingly, the Ministry, in collaboration with Cisco Networking Academy, has initiated a capacity-building drive to equip HR personnel under the Ministry, its attached departments/offices, and educational institutions with essential knowledge in Cybersecurity, Modern AI, and Digital Safety.

4. These internationally recognized, self-paced courses (approximately 6 hours each) aim to enhance cybersecurity awareness, promote responsible and secure use of Artificial Intelligence, and strengthen digital safety practices for effective and secure handling of official work.

5. All Heads of Departments (HoDs) are requested to ensure that their HR personnel (particularly those using Android/iOS mobile devices and digital systems for official work) enroll in these courses. The registration deadline is **8th March 2026**, and strict compliance must be ensured. Detailed guidance and self-enrollment links are available at: <https://skills.moe.gov.pk>

6. Educational institutions are further advised to direct students from Grade 9 onward to enroll and activate their accounts by **8th March 2026**. Students may complete the courses during summer vacations or after final examinations.

7. All Heads of Departments/Organizations are requested to:

- Circulate this directive among all concerned
- Ensure enrollment before the deadline.
- Monitor completion of courses
- Maintain record of certificates for reporting and compliance purposes

8. This may be treated as **Top Priority** in light of the Prime Minister's directive and the increasing cybersecurity risks in the digital domain.
