

Conduct of coaching clinics, training camps, and structured talent identification programs alongside competitions to feed into national development pathways.

- Ensure active participation of all educational boards under IBCC in inter-school, inter-college, and inter-board hockey activities.
- Facilitate coordination among boards and institutions for organizing competitions at all levels.
- Support allocation of funding mechanisms to enable schools and colleges to actively participate.

6. This initiative aligns with our shared national objective of youth engagement, structured sports development, and revival of Pakistan's hockey legacy. With IBCC's leadership, and under the patronage of the Honourable Prime Minister, we are confident that hockey can be re-established as a mainstream competitive sport across educational institutions nationwide.
